- A photocopy of the FRONT & BACK of the registration papers of the horse must accompany all entries; if not included, will be figured as late until received.
- If you are unable to pick up your award, please have someone available to pick them up for you and stand in for pictures. This is very important. We have such generous sponsors and stallion owners and we want to thank them in every way possible.

2D Open Pole Bending Futurity Rules

- The Futurity is open to horses that are five years old or younger. To be eligible for the Futurity, the horse must NEVER have competed in ANY pole bending, including AQHA shows, playdays, novice horse events, derbies, rodeos, etc. prior to November 15, 2023 to do so means forfeiting all fees paid and elimination from the Futurity. However, horses may have competed anywhere after November 15, 2023.
- There will be one go-round. A tipped pole will result in a no time. There will be a 1.5 second split.
- Late entries will be taken up to an hour before the start of the event but will be ran at the end and will pay the \$50 late fee.
